Why this now reaches your desk

Cyberattacks no longer require advanced technical skill; in many cases, a subscription is enough. In May 2026, Verizon reported a first in the nineteen-year history of its Data Breach Investigations Report: unpatched vulnerabilities surpassed stolen credentials as the top way attackers break into businesses. AI now compresses the window from disclosure to exploitation from months to hours. AI-generated phishing is far cheaper than traditional campaigns, and voice cloning can take as little as three seconds of audio. At the same time, 45 percent of employees are entering company data into unapproved AI tools, while small and mid-sized businesses are targeted about four times more often than large enterprises. Something like this will land on your desk. Whether you have a plan by then is up to you.

What you own by 4:00 PM

This is not a webinar, and it is not a technical session. It is a working day for the people who approve the budget, sign the contract, and answer for the outcome. M2 Secure AI Adoption Adopt AI with a fast approval path that keeps sensitive data out of public models. → *Innovation without new exposure*

PHASE 2 · GOVERN & PROTECT

M3 Regulatory Risk & CTEM Map what applies to you and swap annual audits for continuous exposure management. → *Audit- and insurer-ready evidence*

M4 The Human Firewall MFA, least privilege, and a blame-free reporting culture across your team. → *A hardened human layer*

PHASE 3 · ACT & LEAD

M5 Your Three Moves Convert the session into three high-payoff moves with owners, dates, and measures. → *A plan you own by Monday*

M6 The First Hour Lead the first hour: command, communication, containment, and the clocks. → *A rehearsed crisis response*
